CALIFORNIA MID-WINTER FAIR & FIESTA "NO GO-NO SHOW" CODE OF CONDUCT TRAINING

This training is mandatory for all first time Livestock Animal Exhibitors (Primary Members are exempt). For returning exhibitors, this training will be required once every three years – If you took the training for the 2012 Fair, you will not need to take the training again until prior to the 2015 Fair.

There are two training sessions scheduled at the IV Expo (Building TBA):

SENIORS - 7pm-8pm

Saturday, January 12, 2013

JUNIORS - 10am-11am

SENIORS - 11am-12pm

Rules:

*If this is your first time competing at the California Mid-Winter Fair, and you do not attend an Ethics Training, you will not be able to show at the Fair. No Exceptions.

*Showmen who were primary members last year, and regular members for the first time this year will be treated as new members and required to attend this year's training.

*Juniors will not be allowed to attend the Seniors' training, and Seniors will not be allowed to attend the Juniors' training.

*During the training, members will be expected to be quiet and respectful. Disruptive behavior may result in being asked to leave, then both attend and assist with the next training.

- 1) 'No Go No Show' Code of Conduct Training
 - a. **Mandatory** for all **FIRST TIME** 4-H, FFA, Grange and Independent Livestock Animal Exhibitors (4-H <u>Primary Exhibitors</u> are **exempt**)
 - b. **NEW FOR THE 2013 FAIR** -'No Go-No Show' Code of Conduct Training is required once every three years for returning exhibitors. For example, if you attended one 'No Go-No Show' Training for the 2012 California Mid-Winter Fair & Fiesta, you will not need to attend another 'No Go-No Show' Training until prior to the 2015 Fair.
 - c. There are two (2) training sessions scheduled at IV Expo, building TBA:
 - ➤ **Wednesday, January 9, 2013** Parents and Leaders are encouraged to attend.
