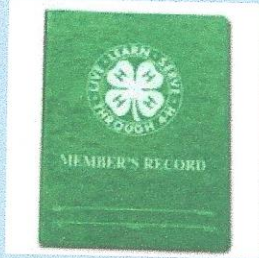

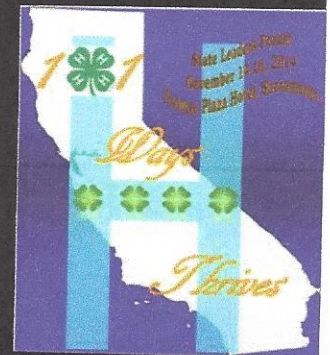


State Leaders Forum (SLF) 2014

Save the date! The 4-H State Leadership Conference brings together high school youth from across California in a four day leadership training, networking, and learning experience.

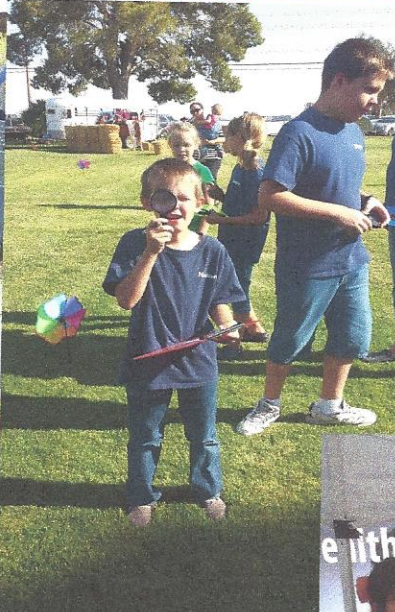
